The Aztec Baseball League would like to thank you for your interest in joining our league. I cannot stress enough that beside the financial commitment it takes to join our league, it is equally important to have enough players that are committed to playing week in and week out during the entire season.

Below you will find what I believe you will need to make your first of hopefully many seasons with us an enjoyable experience for you and your team. Our league runs year-round. We play approximately three seasons a year. We play a 14-game season and schedule our games at various times and locations. Teams that can provide their own home field may qualify for a league discount

The current league fee is \$1,100 if paid before the start of the season or two payments of \$600. The first of two payments are due before the season starts and the 2nd payment would be due before game 8. New teams are also required to pay a one time \$100 refundable umpire deposit. This deposit is basically a forfeit deposit. If for whatever reason a team fails to pay the umpires, those fees will be used to pay. The umpire deposit is fully refundable after leaving our league your team don't have any outstanding balances due. Each team is provided two league approved baseballs for each league game.

The Aztec Baseball League uses Major league baseball rules with only league bylaws as exceptions. These are available anytime on our website (www.aztecbaseballleague.com). Players are required to be at least of 18 years of age. We can make exceptions for players as young as 16, if the parents provide a written release. Each team Managers is responsible for having a player's release on hand. Our league does not assume or imply any kind of player liability.

Teams must provide a team roster which are posted on our website. Rosters are limited to 18 players and a playing Manager. Players may play on only one team per season or teams risks forfeiting all games. Player pictures will also be required to post.

Teams must wear complete and identical baseball jerseys with each player having a unique number on their back. A short grace period is allowed for new teams to comply with the uniform rule

Each season is unique, but we carry as many as 6 divisions. The divisions are the AAA division (wood bat only), AA division, A division, and an B division.

Teams are responsible for paying the umpires fees at each of their games. The current rates are \$60 per team if two umpires are present or \$50 per team for only one umpire. Teams that qualify for the playoffs play a single elimination playoff tournament. All 8-team division winning teams get a \$250 league fee credit.

During the regular season, we meet approximately 4 teams a season on Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m. Check out our website for the next date. Additional meetings may be necessary during the season. All information will be posted on our website as it becomes available.
